If your student misses 5 or more words from this list, lessons 31-60 would be beneficial for their spelling mastery. Take the pre-assessment for lessons 1-30 as well to see if those lessons would be beneficial, too.

Lessons 1-30 also teach short and long vowels, digraphs, diphthongs, combinations, diacritical coding, syllable division, and accent concepts that are pertinent to spelling, so if your student is not familiar with those concepts, they would still benefit from building those skills in lessons 1-30 before lessons 31-75.
